

Inventory and preservation of historical documentation and sources

- The essential archival source is the chronicle book entitled “Dr. phil. h. c. Heinrich Lumpes Lebenswerk in der Presse” (Heinrich Lumpe’s Life Work in Print). It is a giant publication measuring 520 mm in height, 410 mm in width and 200 mm thick. It has 500 pages and weighs 24 kg. It contains mainly newspaper clippings with articles about H. Lumpe’s activities. In addition, it includes a number of original photographs, almost all publications issued by the park, plus samples of correspondence with important personalities and ordinary visitors, invitations to events organised by the park and typescripts of speeches given at them, as well as sheet music of songs and poems composed for Lumpe on the subject of nature conservation, etc. The form in which the archive has survived to this day dates from 1935; the first records date back to 1908.

- A set of photographs from the collections of the Museum of the City of Ústí nad Labem showing the Lumpe Park grounds (approx. 150 shots prior to 1945, approx. 230 shots after 1945, 3 shots – H. Lumpe’s portraits)
- Inventory of historical publications from the library of the Museum of the City of Ústí nad Labem – 10 publications
